PURPOSE

This program is designed to develop dairy leaders to ensure the role of dairy foods and dairy farming in the future of sustaining our people, planet and communities.

ELIGIBILITY

Idaho and Utah dairy farmers who are actively involved in a dairy operation or those taking leadership/management roles on a dairy. Individuals should aspire to serve in leadership roles such as board service.
